Galatians 3:10 For all who rely on works of the law are under a curse; for it is written, "Cursed be everyone who does not abide by all things written in the Book of the Law, and do them."

Deuteronomy 27:26 "Cursed be anyone who does not confirm the words of this law by doing them'...
