LOVE TAKES

Galatians 6:1 Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted. 2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

1. The Spirit leads believers to take responsibility for EACH OTHER.

Galatians 6:1 Brothers, if anyone is caught in any transgression, you who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness....

- a. Restore each other GENTLY.

Galatians 6:1 ...Keep watch on yourself, lest you too be tempted.

- b. Restore each other CAREFULLY.

Galatians 6:3 For if anyone thinks he is something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself. 4 But let each one test his own work, and then his reason to boast will be in himself alone and not in his neighbor. 5 For each will have to bear his own load.

2. The Spirit leads believers to take responsibility for THEMSELVES.

Galatians 6:3 For if anyone thinks he is something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself.

a. Cultivate HUMILITY.

Galatians 6:4 But let each one test his own work, and then his reason to boast will be in himself alone and not in his neighbor.

b. Draw a CIRCLE.

LOVE GIVES

*Galatians 6:6 Let the one who is taught the word **share** all good things with the one who teaches. 7 Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one **sows**, that will he also reap. 8 For the one who **sows** to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who **sows** to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life. 9 And let us not grow weary of **doing good**, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. 10 So then, as we have opportunity, let us **do good** to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.*

The Spirit leads believers to SHARE their time, talent, and treasure.

Galatians 6:6 Let the one who is taught the word share all good things with the one who teaches.

1. Enable healthy TEACHING.

Galatians 6:7 Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. 8 For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.

2. Trust God's JUSTICE.

Galatians 6:9 And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up.

3. Work your PATIENCE muscles.

Galatians 6:10 So then, as we have opportunity,...

4. Leave it all IN the field.

Galatians 6:10 ...let us do good to everyone,...

5. Give without JUDGMENT.

Galatians 6:10 ...and especially to those who are of the household of faith.

6. Prioritize your Christian COMMUNITY.
