Today, on average...

- Sub-Saharan Africa: 63% Christian
- Caribbean Islands: 82% Christian
- Latin America: 92% Christian

Today, there are 2.6 billion Christians around the world!

An **unreached people group** (UPG) is a people group that is less than 5% Christian and 2% Evangelical. This means these groups lack a local church community large enough to evangelize the rest of their people, so they need outside (e.g. missionary) assistance.

- 3 billion people alive today still belong to an UPG.
- 74% of all unreached people groups today live in Asia.
- Only a mere 4% of all missionaries work among UPGs!

Some UPGs mentioned in today's message:

- Ethnic Thai Buddhists: 55 million, 1% Christian
- Oshari* (atheist): 30 million, 1.6% Christian
- Shoptar* (Muslim): 79 million, 0.003% Christian
