### **LET'S SET UP THE STORY:**

Galatians 1:1 Paul, an apostle—not from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father...

# THE QUESTION IS...

# "...Am I trying to PLEASE man?"

Galatians 1:10 For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ.

### THE STATEMENT IS...

"The gospel that was preached by me is....
RECEIVED...through a revelation of Jesus Christ."

Galatians 1:11 For I would have you know, brothers, that the gospel that was preached by me is not man's gospel. 12 For I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.

### PAUL'S FLASHBACK TO HIS FORMER LIFE

Galatians 1:13 For you have heard of my former life in Judaism, how I persecuted the church of God violently and tried to destroy it. 14 And I was advancing in Judaism beyond many of my own age among my people, so extremely zealous was I for the traditions of my fathers.

- 1. He was a VIOLENT man who "Believed" and "Achieved."
- 2. He was a people-pleaser...this is an IDOL.

Galatians 1:10 ...If I were <u>still</u> trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ.

- 3. The three idols of "man's gospel".
  - a. Pleasing people...a need for VALUE.
  - b. Zealous effort...a need for SUCCESS.
  - c. Traditions & Rules...a need for CONTROL.

### **BUT...A REVELATION OF JESUS!**

Galatians 1:15 But when he who had <u>set me apart before I was born</u>, and who <u>called</u> <u>me by his grace</u>, 16 <u>was pleased to reveal his Son to me</u>, in order <u>that I might preach</u> <u>him</u> among the Gentiles,...

- God, the Father, set YOU apart before YOU were born, called YOU by his grace and was pleased to reveal his Son to YOU.
- 2. God, the Father, has a purpose for Paul and YOU too.

### THE REVELATION CONTINUES...

Galatians 1:16b-20 I did not immediately consult with <u>anyone</u>; 17 nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me, but I went away into Arabia, and returned again to Damascus.

1. Not from FLESH and BLOOD.

Matthew 16:17 And Jesus answered him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah! For <u>flesh and blood</u> has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven."

2. THREE years with Jesus...

1 Corinthians 15:3 For I delivered to you as of first importance <u>what I also</u> <u>received</u>: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures.

3. And a 15 day "VISIT" in Jerusalem with Peter and James.

Galatians 1:18 Then after three years I went up to Jerusalem to visit Cephas and remained with him fifteen days. 19 But I saw none of the other apostles except James the Lord's brother. 20 (In what I am writing to you, before God, I do not lie!)

#### THE STORY OF A RECOVERING PEOPLE-PLEASER

Galatians 1:21 Then I went into the regions of Syria and Cilicia. 22 And I was still unknown in person to the churches of Judea that are in Christ.

- 1. Paul goes back home as an "UNKNOWN" for 11 years!
- 2. What season are you in: RECOVERY? TRAINING?
- 3. Who gets the GLORY?

Galatians 1:23-24 They only were hearing it said, "He who used to persecute us is now preaching the faith he once tried to destroy." 24 And they glorified God because of me.
