
CHRISTMAS AT EMMANUEL

THE CONTEXT

"The Works of the Law"

"Faith in Christ"

rule-keepers "sinners"

Ephesians 2:14 For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility 15 by abolishing the law of commandments expressed in ordinances, that he might create in himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace, 16 and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross,...

- 1. Like Peter at Antioch, the Galatians were sliding into the ditch of an EARNING mindset.
- 2. They were falling for the lie that ACCESS to God was only for those who earned it by following the rules.

ASK YOURSELF:

 In what ways might I be living the Christian life with an earning mindset?

THE CONTRADICTION

Galatians 2:17 But if, in our endeavor to be justified in Christ, we too were found to be sinners, **is Christ then a servant of sin**?...

1. To cling to earning is to INSULT Christ.

Galatians 2:17 ...Certainly not! 18 For if I rebuild what I tore down, I prove myself to be a transgressor.

2. To cling to earning is to CONTRADICT Christ.

ASK YOURSELF:

What am I afraid I'll lose if I let go of earning?

THE CLARITY

Galatians 2:19 For through the law I died to the law, so that I might **live** to God. 20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who **live**, but Christ who **lives** in me. And the **life** I now **live** in the flesh I **live** by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

1. We have to let go of earning to find LIFE.

Galatians 2:19 For through the law I died to the law, so that I might live to God.

a. ADMIT that on your own your life is unmanageable.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who **live**, but Christ who **lives** in me....

b. ACCEPT the "wonderful exchange." (2 Corinthians 5:21)

"By a wonderful exchange our sins are now not ours but Christ's, and Christ's righteousness is not Christ's but ours."

Galatians 2:20 ... And the **life** I now **live** in the flesh I **live** by faith in the Son of God, ...

c. ADJUST to Spirit-led freedom in Christ.

Galatians 2:20 ...who loved me and gave himself for me.

d. ABSORB the reality that God really does love you.

ASK YOURSELF:

 Which part of Galatians 2:19-20 am I most challenged by, and why?

Galatians 2:21 I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose.

2. We have to let go of earning to embrace CHRIST.

ASK THE LORD:

Heavenly Father, thank you for your relentless love for us.
Jesus, thank you for laying down your life and making a
way for us to find life through You. Holy Spirit, thank you
for the transformation you are working to accomplish in us.
God, help us to stand firm in gospel freedom.
