Today's Points:

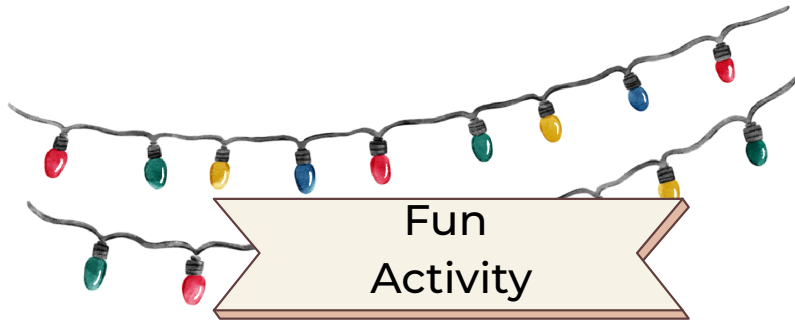
- Today the preschoolers learned that God gives them joy.
