

Day 4: READ → Psalm 100:1-5

READ & PRAISE → Prayer isn't only asking God for help. Prayer is also a way to tell God how amazing He is! We can praise Him because He loves us, cares for us, keeps His promises, and is always faithful. When we spend time praising God, our hearts grow closer to Him.

Say a prayer that only praises God. Try not to ask Him for anything. Start each sentence with "**God, thank You for...**" or "**God, You are...**" See if you can think of at least **five** things to praise Him for.

★ Praise Ideas:

You love me.
You made me.
You always keep Your promises.
You forgive my sins.
You are always with me.

PRAY → *Dear God, thank You for who You are, and help me praise You with all my heart. Amen.*

Big Picture Question: What is prayer? *Prayer is talking with God to praise Him, ask Him for help, and confess our sins.*

Main Point: Jesus raised a widow's son to life.

Day 1: READ → Luke 7:11-13

READ & DO → Jesus arrived at a town called Nain just as a funeral was taking place. A widow had lost her only son, and she was heartbroken. Before anyone asked Him for help, Jesus noticed her sadness. He cared deeply for her and said, "Don't cry." Jesus has a heart full of compassion. He sees when we are sad, scared, or hurting, and He cares about us too.

Day 2: READ → Luke 7:14-17

READ & ANSWER → Do you know someone who has died? _____

It's very sad when someone dies. I have some good news for you today though. Jesus walked over to the young man in the story today and said, "Young man, I say to you, get up!" Immediately, the young man came back to life and began to speak! Everyone was amazed and praised God because they saw that Jesus has power that no one else has—even power over death. This miracle reminds us that Jesus is God's powerful Son who brings hope and life.

PRAY → *Jesus, thank You for being God's powerful Son who gives us hope and life. Amen.*

Day 3: READ → Jeremiah 29:12-13

READ & MEMORIZE → God promises that when we truly look for Him, we will find Him! We don't have to wonder if God wants us near Him. He does! We can learn more about Him by reading the Bible, praying, and listening when others teach us about Him.

Read our memory verse below aloud three times. Cover up one or two words and say it again. Keep covering more words until you can say the whole verse from memory. Then tell it to someone in your family!
