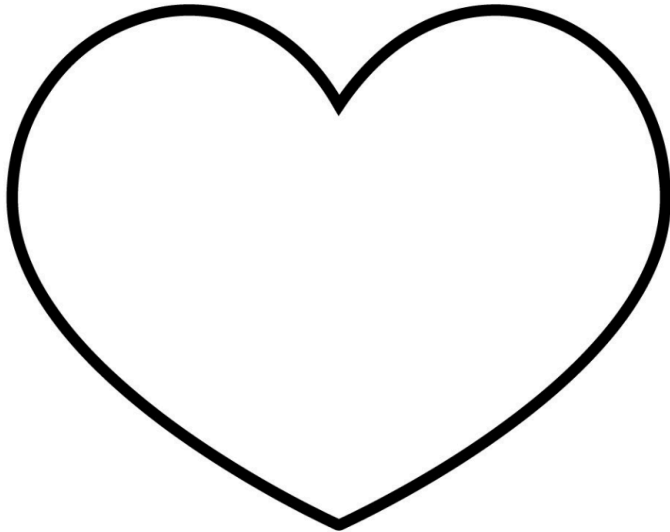


Day 4: READ → John 2:23-25
