

Day 4: READ → Jeremiah 29:12-13

READ & PRAY → God promises that when we pray to Him and truly seek Him, He hears us. Confessing our sins means telling God the truth about the wrong things we've done and asking Him to forgive us. Because of Jesus, we can always come to God. He is ready to listen and forgive when we come with sincere hearts.

Take a quiet moment to pray. Tell God about anything you've done wrong and thank Him for loving and forgiving you through Jesus.

PRAY → *Father, thank You for listening to me, forgiving my sins through Jesus, and helping me seek You with all my heart. Amen.*

Big Picture Question: What is prayer? *Prayer is talking with God to praise Him, ask Him for help, and confess our sins.*

Main Point: Jesus forgave a woman's sin.

Day 1: READ → Luke 7:36-38

READ & DO → A woman who had made many wrong choices heard that Jesus was eating at Simon's house.

She bravely walked in carrying a jar of expensive perfume. She cried as she knelt by Jesus' feet. Her tears showed how sorry she was for her sins. She wiped His feet with her hair and poured the perfume on them because she loved Jesus.

The woman wasn't worried about what everyone else thought. She wanted to be close to Jesus because she knew He could forgive her. Spray a squirt of perfume on today's devotion as a reminder of her love for Jesus.

Think about a time you did something wrong. Jesus wants us to come to Him just like the woman did.

PRAY → *Jesus, help me come to You with an honest and sorry heart. Amen.*

Day 2: READ → Luke 7:39-43

READ & CIRCLE → Simon looked at the woman and only saw her mistakes. But Jesus saw something different. Jesus told a story about two people who had debts they could not pay. When both debts were forgiven, the person forgiven the most loved the lender even more. Jesus wanted Simon to understand that people who know they have been forgiven love God deeply.

Day 3: READ → Luke 7:44-50

READ & RESPOND → Jesus told the woman, "Your sins are forgiven." What wonderful words! Jesus wasn't just kind. He had the power to forgive her sins! The woman left with peace because she trusted Jesus.

When we confess our sins to Jesus, He forgives us too. We don't have to hide from Him. He loves us and wants us to follow Him every day.
