

Day 4: READ → John 3:18-21

READ & DISCUSS → Jesus said He is the light. Some people choose darkness (sin), but others choose the light and follow Him. When we follow Jesus, we live in truth and light!

Why do most people who do evil want to do it in the darkness?

Why is it better to be in the light?

How can we show God's light today?

When we follow Jesus and obey the commands of the Bible, we show people we love the light. Obeying God and living "Christ-like" are great examples to others that we love the light, we want nothing to do with darkness. What a wonderful life we can have in the light! 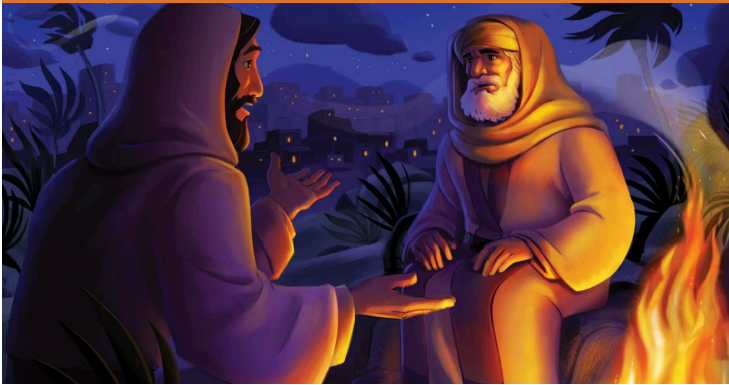

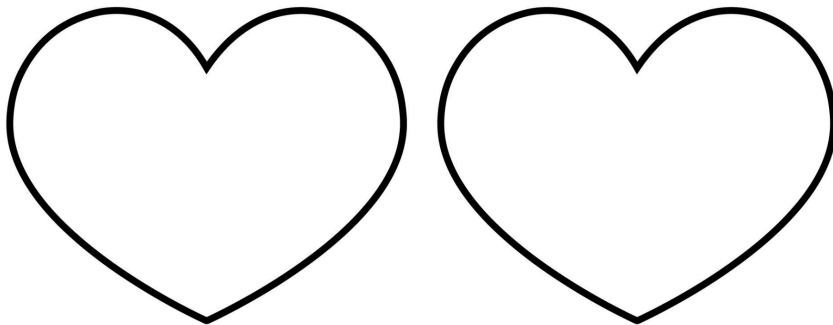
JESUS AND NICODEMUS



Day 2: READ → John 3:4-8

READ & DESCRIBE → Nicodemus didn't understand what Jesus meant. Jesus explained that being born again isn't about your body—it's about your heart. God makes us new on the inside!
