

Day 4: READ → Luke 18:9–14

READ & CHECK → Jesus told about two men who prayed. One bragged about himself, but the other admitted he needed God's mercy. Jesus said God was pleased with the humble man. Prayer is not about showing off. It is about honestly talking to God and trusting Him to forgive and help us.

Luke 11, 18

Big Picture Question: What is prayer? *Prayer is talking with God to praise Him, ask Him for help, and confess our sins.*

Main Point: Jesus taught people to keep praying to God.

Day 1: READ → Luke 11:1–4

READ & CIRCLE → The disciples watched Jesus pray and wanted to learn how to pray like He did. Jesus taught them a simple prayer that reminds us God is our loving Father. We praise Him, ask Him to help us obey Him, trust Him to provide what we need, ask for forgiveness, and ask Him to help us stay away from sin.

Day 2: READ → Luke 11:5-13

READ & DRAW → Jesus told a story about a man who kept asking for help until his friend answered the door. Then Jesus said, "Ask...Seek...Knock." Jesus wants us to keep praying because God loves to hear from His children. God always knows what is best and gives good gifts to those who trust Him.

Draw three doors below and write Ask, Seek Knock in each door.

PRAY → *Dear God, help me to keep praying and to trust that You always hear me. Amen.*

Day 3: READ → Luke 18:1-8

READ & WRITE → Jesus told a story about a woman who never gave up asking for justice. Even though the judge did not care about people, he finally helped her because she kept asking. Jesus wants us to remember that God is much more loving than that judge! We should never stop praying because God hears us and cares for us.
