Big Picture Question: What did Jesus teach when He was on earth? *Jesus taught about God and His kingdom. He taught that all Scripture is about Him.*

Main Point: Jesus taught how people in God's kingdom live.

Day 1: READ → Matthew 5:1-12

READ & ANSWER → Jesus gathered His disciples and began teaching them. He said that people who love God, trust Him, show mercy, make peace, and stay faithful are truly blessed. Being blessed doesn't always mean life is easy. It means God is with us and cares for us. Jesus wants us to have hearts that look more like His every day. PRAY → *Jesus, help me live in a way that shows Your love and brings blessings to others. Amen.*

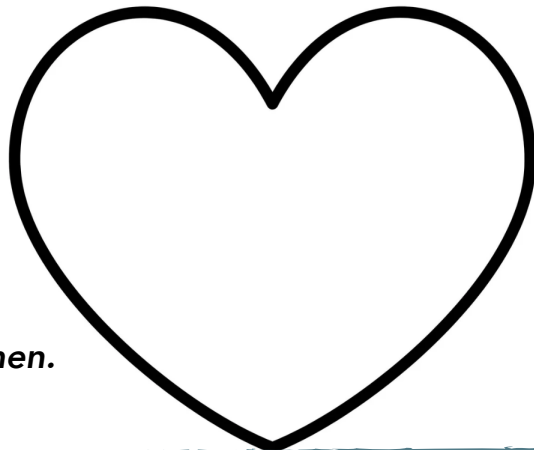
JESUS' SERMON ON THE MOUNT



Day 2: READ → Matthew 5:17-20

READ & WRITE → Jesus told the people that He did not come to erase God's Word. He came to fulfill it perfectly. No one can obey God's commands perfectly but Jesus did! When we trust Him, He helps us love God and obey Him from our hearts instead of just following rules. Write one way you can obey Jesus this week inside your heart.

PRAY → *Jesus, thank You for obeying God perfectly and helping me follow You every day. Amen.*



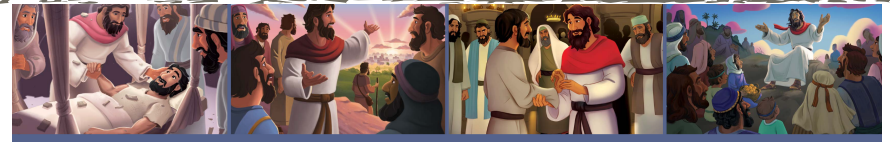
Day 3: READ → Matthew 6:1-15

READ & DO → Jesus taught that we don't have to pray to impress other people. We pray because we love God and want to spend time with Him. Jesus even gave His disciples a model prayer to help them know how to pray. We can praise God, ask for what we need, tell Him we're sorry, forgive others, and ask Him to help us make good choices.

Trace one of your hands on a piece of paper.
On each finger write one thing:

- **Thumb:** Something you can thank God for.
- **Pointer Finger:** Someone you can pray for.
- **Middle Finger:** Something you need God's help with.
- **Ring Finger:** Someone you need to forgive.
- **Pinky Finger:** One way you want to obey Jesus this week.

PRAY → *Father, thank You for listening whenever I pray and helping me trust You every day. Amen.*
