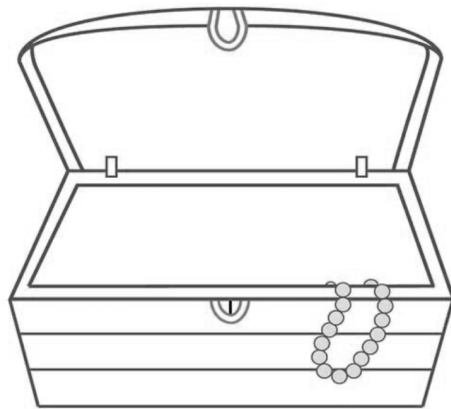


Day 4: READ → Luke 12:32–34

READ & CHECK → Jesus said we should store up treasure in heaven instead of only collecting treasures on earth. Heavenly treasure grows when we love God, obey Him, worship Him, and generously help others. The things we buy won't last forever, but the things we do for God will. Draw or write inside the treasure chest a treasure God loves.

Big Picture Question: What is prayer? *Prayer is talking with God to praise Him, ask Him for help, and confess our sins.*

Main Point: Jesus taught people to seek God's kingdom.

Day 1: READ → Luke 12:13–21

READ & DRAW → A man wanted Jesus to help him get more money. Instead of talking about money, Jesus told a story about a rich man who stored up lots of food and treasures. The man thought having more stuff would make him happy and safe. But he forgot that loving God is much more important than collecting things. What is something you own that you really like? Draw a picture of it below. Then, draw a cross beside your picture to remind yourself that Jesus is even more valuable than anything you own.

PRAY → *Jesus, help me love You more than anything I have. Amen.*

Day 2: READ → Luke 12:22–28

READ & LOOK → Jesus pointed to the birds and flowers. Birds don't plant gardens, yet God feeds them. Flowers don't make their own beautiful clothes, yet God dresses them with amazing colors. If God takes such good care of birds and flowers, imagine how much He cares for you!

Go outside or look through a window. Find one bird or one flower. Thank God for taking care of His creation and thank Him for taking care of you too.



PRAY → *Jesus, thank You for always taking care of me. Amen.*

Day 3: READ → Luke 12:29–31

READ & DO → Jesus doesn't want us to spend all our time worrying about what we'll eat, drink, or wear. Instead, He wants us to put God first every day. When we follow Him, trust Him, and obey Him, we can know He will provide what we truly need.
