## JESUS AND THE SAMARITAN WOMAN

*John 4*

**Big Picture Question:** Did Jesus ever sin?

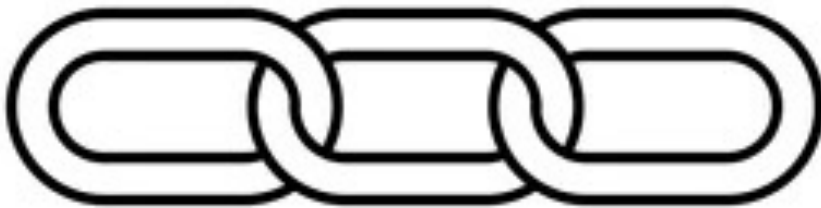
*No, Jesus never sinned.*

**Main Point:** Jesus told the Samaritan woman that He is the Messiah.

Day 4: **READ** → John 4:27–42

**READ & WRITE** → The first thing the woman did after speaking to Jesus was to tell the other Samaritans about Jesus. The Samaritan woman's testimony (or story) led many to Jesus. We also can share the good news of Jesus with others. We all have a story (testimony) of how Jesus met with us. You are the only person in the world with your testimony. Be ready to share it with others. God can use it to bring many others to Himself.

Day 1: **READ** → John 4:1–9

**READ & DRAW** → Jesus stopped at a well in Samaria and met a woman there. She was surprised because Jews usually didn't talk to Samaritans, but Jesus did.

Jesus meets us where we are. He sees and values everyone—even people others ignore. Jesus is with you EVERYWHERE!

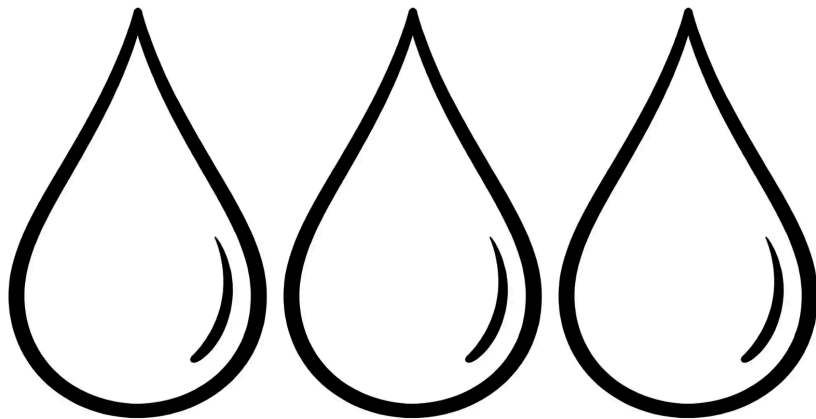
**PRAY** → *Jesus, thank You for loving me and being with me everywhere I go. Amen.*

## JESUS AND THE SAMARITAN WOMAN



Day 2: READ → John 4:10–15

READ & WRITE → Draw or write some ways we use water in the droplets below.



Jesus told the woman about “living water” that gives eternal life and never runs out. Only Jesus can satisfy our deepest needs.

PRAY → *Jesus, help me remember that only You can fill my heart with what I really need. Amen.*

Day 3: READ → John 4:16–26

READ & DISCUSS → Women in Jesus' day typically drew water in groups in the morning. It was a social occasion and a daily chore. Being alone at midday suggests that the Samaritan woman was a social outcast and shunned from others.

As the woman approached Jesus, He gently showed the woman that He knew her whole life. She has had five husbands and is currently living with a man that is not her husband.

Discuss with your family one thing you might try to hide from others.

Jesus goes out of His way to meet the Samaritan woman and change her life forever. Let this story be a reminder that Jesus knows everything about you and still loves you!

PRAY → *Jesus, thank You for loving me completely and knowing everything about me. Amen.*
