STORY POINT:

Bible Story Recap:



- Before King David died, he told his son Solomon, "Be brave and do what God says."
 Then Solomon became the king of Israel.
- One night, God spoke to Solomon in a dream. God said, "I will give you anything you ask for." Solomon wanted to be a good king. He asked God to give him wisdom.
- God was happy with Solomon. He gave him wisdom and other things too. Solomon went to the tabernacle and worshiped God.
