Bible Story Recap:



- Solomon was the richest and wisest man in the world. He was famous and powerful.
 King Solomon learned an important lesson, and he wrote a book about it.
- This is how the book starts: "The Teacher says, 'Everything is kind of pointless.' People are born, people die, and the world keeps going around. The sun goes up and down. The wind blows.
- "Rivers flow into the sea, but the sea never gets too full. What you do today, you'll
 have to do again tomorrow. And many years from now, people won't even remember
 you."
- Solomon said that the most important thing is to know God and follow Him.


