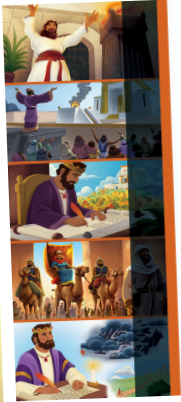


Read: I Kings 10
