

Day 4: READ → Proverbs 3:7

READ & RESPOND → This verse means that it's not good to think you know everything or that you're always right. It's important to be open to learning from others and from God. To "fear the LORD" means having a deep respect and reverence for God. It does not mean to literally be fearful of Him.

Look up the definition of biblical wisdom and discuss what it means.

Who is someone you know that is wise?

What makes them wise?

Day 2: READ → 1 Kings 3:1-9

READ & ANSWER → If I told you today that I was going on a vacation and I needed you to water my plants while I was away, what would you need to do the job?

What if I had a rip in my clothes that needed to be fixed? What would you need to do the job?

In today's reading, Solomon had a big job. He was the king and needed to lead a lot of people. What did Solomon ask God for to do his job?

PRAY → *God, thank you for being a God who gives wisdom. I want to follow your will and be a good example. Amen.*

Day 3: READ → 1 Kings 3:10-15

READ & DISCUSS → King Solomon asked God for wisdom so he could help the people do what is right. Solomon gained great wisdom from God. People would come to Solomon from far away and ask him for advice. Today, the Bible tells us what is right. We get God's wisdom from the Bible. Discuss what the Bible tells us is right to do in each of the following situations...

You keep playing after you are told to get ready for bed.

You ignore a sick neighbor.

You lie rather than admitting that you did not brush your teeth.


You complain when asked to take a bath.
