SOLOMON THOUGHT ABOUT LIFE


Ecclesiastes 1

Big Picture Question: What does God know? *God knows everything about the past, present, and future.*

Main Point: Solomon built a temple for God to dwell with His people.

Day 1: READ → Read intro page to Ecclesiastes if your Bible has that! If not, read the subtitles throughout the book of Ecclesiastes. **READ & ANSWER** → Ecclesiastes is the second of King Solomon's wisdom books. King Solomon was not only wise, but he was also very rich and famous. He could have anything he wanted in the world. King Solomon went on a quest to find what would really make him happy and he wrote about his discoveries in this book. Make a list of 3 things that make you happy... 3.

PRAY → God, YOU make me happy! Amen.



Day 2: READ → Ecclesiastes 1:1-11

READ & DISCUSS → King Solomon makes some strong statements of how hopeless life appears "under the sun". Everything we do and experience on earth is "under the sun"... our homes, schools, families, cars, toys, everything! If all we think about and live for is "under the sun", life can indeed seem "pointless".

We need to learn to look "above the sun" to Jesus where we will find true satisfaction, joy, and meaning. Look to Jesus every day! Welcome Him into everything you do! Make Him the treasure of your heart. Discuss as a family ways that you can welcome Jesus into everything that you do.
