Main Point: God sent Jonah to Nineveh to tell the people to turn from their sinful ways.


Day 1: **READ** → **Jonah** 1:1-17

READ & DISCUSS → Has your mom or dad ever told you to do something? They may say "Can you please put your shoes away?". You FINALLY do what they ask. Jonah was like this too. Jonah ran away from God's first request for him to go to Nineveh and then we see God save Jonah even after disobeying. He uses that great big fish to rescue him from drowning in the sea. Discuss the following questions...

When have you got a second chance when you need one?
After Jonah warned the Ninevites, what did they do?

What did the king do next?
What did God do when he saw their actions?
What does this chapter tell us about God?
