Big Picture Question: What is God like? *God is holy, good, and loving.*

Main Point: Judah's good kings worshiped God.

Day 1: READ → 2 Kings 18:1-7; 19:10-19, 32-34

READ & PRAY → King Hezekiah reopened the doors of the temple and honored God. When Hezekiah had been king for 14 years Sennacherib, the king of Assyria, attacked some cities in Judah. Hezekiah began to pray. God heard Hezekiah's prayer and sent Isaiah the prophet with His answer. God was going to protect His city Jerusalem and His people. Hezekiah believed God would help and prayed confidently when he was facing an attack from King Sennacherib. What is something that you need to pray about confidently to God? Day 2: READ → 2 Chronicles 14:2-7; 15:1-9

READ & ANSWER → King Asa sought God with all his heart and God gave him peace with his neighbors. When the prophet Azariah told King Asa that God was with him and his people, he removed all of the idols and repaired the altar of the Lord. The people decided to turn to the Lord their God, and God was there to help. Today, we can seek God, turning away from idols and other things that take away our attention.

What can you do this week to seek and serve God?

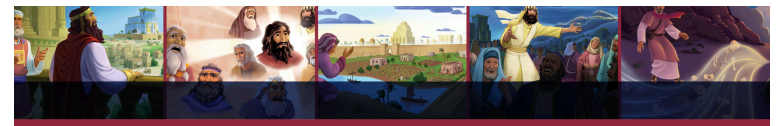
PRAY → *God, I want to seek your face. Help me live out my love for you every day. Amen.*
