

Day 4: READ → Zechariah 5:5-11, 6:1-8, 9:9

READ → The 7th vision was a small basket with a lid to represent the woman in a basket. Meaning: Sin will be carried away.



The 8th vision was a horse-drawn chariot to represent the 4 chariots. Meaning: God will overcome evil in the 4 corners of the world and bring rest.



God always gives us hope in our difficult times. The ultimate hope for us all was predicted in Zechariah 9:9. Zechariah predicted 500 years before it happened, that Jesus would come riding on a donkey into the very town the returning exiles were rebuilding at the time. **God sent Jesus to us all to take away sin and give hope!!!**

THE PROPHET ZECHARIAH

Zechariah 1-14

Big Picture Question: How did God plan to fix what sin broke? *Before He created the world, God planned to send the Messiah.*

Main Point: Zechariah shared that God's kingdom will be established forever.

Day 1: READ → Zechariah 1:7-21

READ & RESPOND → Describe a dream that you have had recently or in the past...

Zechariah was sent by God to encourage the people of Israel as they began to rebuild the city of Jerusalem after returning from 70 years of captivity. They were facing challenges as they attempted this difficult task. Zechariah had 8 visions which were special messages from God to bring encouragement to continue their work. Each vision and its message gave hope to the people of Israel. Unlike dreams (which occur during sleep), visions are like dreams but often when a person is awake.



The 1st vision was a man on a red horse. **Color the horse red.** The meaning: A messenger bringing the message that God still loves Israel and will restore their land.



The 2nd vision was a deer antler to represent the 4 horns. Meaning: God will defeat 4 enemies of Israel – Assyria, Egypt, Babylon, Persia.

Day 2: READ → Zechariah 2:1-13 & 3:1-10

READ → The 3rd vision was a rope to represent a surveyor who was measuring the city. Meaning: Jerusalem will measure larger and safer than before it was destroyed.



The 4th vision was a Bible character figure to represent Joshua the whose filthy clothes were exchanged for clean. Meaning: God will send the Great High Priest, the King of Kings, to cleanse us from our sins.



PRAY → *God, Thank You for sending Your prophets to encourage the people and thank You that You're always faithful. Amen.*

Day 3: READ → Zechariah 4:1-14 & 5:1-4

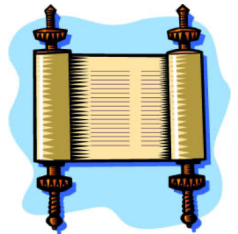
The 5th vision was a candle holder to represent the golden



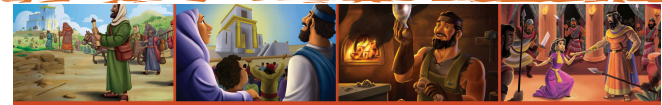
which was used in the Temple for worship. Meaning: The Temple will be rebuilt and God will dwell among them.

The 6th vision was a flying

made out of paper and sticks. Meaning: Those who were disobeying God's law and stopping God's work would be punished.
