STORY POINT:

Malachi told the people to remember God's promises.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

Malachi was a messenger for God. He told about another messenger—John the Baptist—who would get people ready for the last messenger, Jesus! Jesus is God's Son who came to rescue people from sin.




Read: Malachi

Bible Story Recap:



- The Jewish people were waiting for God to bless them, but nothing happened. They wondered if God still loved them.
- God loved them, but they were making wrong choices, called sin, so He sent Malachi to warn them and remind them to do the right things.
- Malachi said God would send a special person to get people ready for Jesus, the Savior.
- After Malachi, no more messengers came from God for a long time, but after hundreds of years, John the Baptist would come to get people ready for Jesus.



What is the Bible about?

The Bible is about God's plan to save people through Jesus.
