THE PEOPLE WORSHIPED GOD

Nehemiah 7-13

Big Picture Question: What is the Bible about?
The Bible is the story of God's plan to save people through Jesus.

Main Point: God's people confessed their sin and promised to faithfully obey Him.

Day 1: **READ** → Nehemiah 7:1-7

READ & WRITE → After the walls were finished, Nehemiah put faithful people in charge. Then he gathered everyone to remember their families and how God had brought them back home. Verses 8-73 were the lists of people that returned from exile. God cared about every single person!

Day 2: READ → Nehemiah 9:1-8

READ & PRAY → Nehemiah 9 tells us that the people stood and listened to the book of the Law for many hours. They remembered all the amazing things God had done for them! They thanked Him for choosing Abraham and keeping His promises. The people confessed their sins and praised God for being faithful and loving. Admitting mistakes and asking for forgiveness restores our relationship with God and brings joy. Confession is not just saying sorry, but deciding to turn around and follow God again.

Day 3: READ → Nehemiah 9:9-21
