THE OLD TESTAMENT POINTS TO JESUS

Luke 1, John 1

Big Picture Question: What is the Bible about?
The Bible is the story of God's plan to save people through Jesus.

Main Point: John was sent by God as a witness to the coming Messiah.

Day 1: READ → Luke 1:5-25


READ & PLAY → In the Old Testament, the prophets spoke God's messages to encourage people to turn away from sin and back to God. But after the prophet Malachi, there were no more prophetic messages from God for 400 years. It was SILENT.

The New Testament starts with a priest, Zechariah, and he was SILENCED for doubting God.

Play the Quiet Game. The rules are simple. Everyone must remain completely quiet. There can be no talking, not even a whisper, and no laughing or giggling. If you make a sound, you are out of the game and the last one to not make a sound is the winner of the game. The quiet game is fun to play, but after a while, you get tired of not being able to speak. I wonder what it would be like to go for a whole day or an entire week without speaking? What about for months like Zechariah?

PRAY → *God, I am thankful that even in the silence you are always at work. Amen.*

THE OLD TESTAMENT POINTS TO JESUS



Day 2: **READ** → Luke 1:57-66, 80

READ & ANSWER → Zechariah and Elizabeth were going to have a baby!

When the baby was born what did everyone think his name should be?

What did they name their son?

Discuss with your parents how and why they chose your name.

PRAY → *God, thank you for my name. Thank you for my voice. May it be used to praise You! Amen.*

Day 3: **READ** → John 1:19–28

READ & WRITE → John the Baptist told everyone to get ready because Jesus was coming! He wasn't the Savior—he just helped people get their hearts ready to meet Him. John wanted everyone to know that Jesus was the most important One.

How can you help others get to know Jesus?

Write one way you can tell someone about Jesus this week.

PRAY → *God, help me point others to Jesus by my words and actions. Amen.*
