
JESUS WAS BORN

God kept His promise to send a Savior! This is very good news. Jesus was not like other babies. He is God's Son! God sent Jesus into the world to save people from their sins.




Read: Matthew 1; Luke 1-2

Bible Story Recap:



- An angel visited a young woman named Mary who was going to be married to a man named Joseph. The angel said, "The Lord is with you!"
- Mary was surprised and a little scared. The angel said she was going to have a baby, and the baby would be God's Son.
- Then an angel visited Joseph in a dream. The angel said, "Mary is going to have a baby. Name the baby Jesus because He will save His people from their sins."
- Mary and Joseph went to Bethlehem, and that is where Jesus was born. An angel appeared and said, "I have very good news: Today a Savior was born for you in the city of David." The shepherds hurried to Bethlehem and found Baby Jesus.
