Jesus wanted the people to believe that He is the King and Savior of the world. God wants all people to turn away from their sin, trust in Jesus, and receive life with God forever.

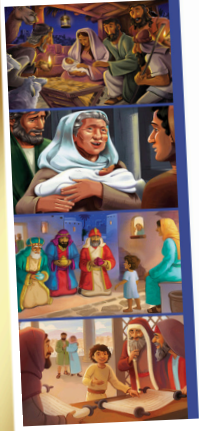


Read: Matthew 21; Mark 11; Luke 19; John 12

## Bible Story Recap:



- Jesus and His friends were walking to Jerusalem. Jesus asked two of His friends to go ahead and find a donkey. The friends found the donkey, and Jesus sat on it.
- This happened because a long time ago, a prophet wrote that a special King would ride on a donkey. Jesus made these words come true!
- A big crowd of people came and put their coats and palm branches on the road for Jesus. They shouted, "Hosanna! Hosanna!"
- Some people didn't like the cheering. They told Jesus to make everyone be quiet. Jesus said, "If they're quiet, even the rocks will talk!"

## Big Question & Answer

### Serve:



When Jesus rode into Jerusalem, some of the people threw their cloaks on the ground in front of Him, which was a way to worship Him as King.
