DEVOTIONAL

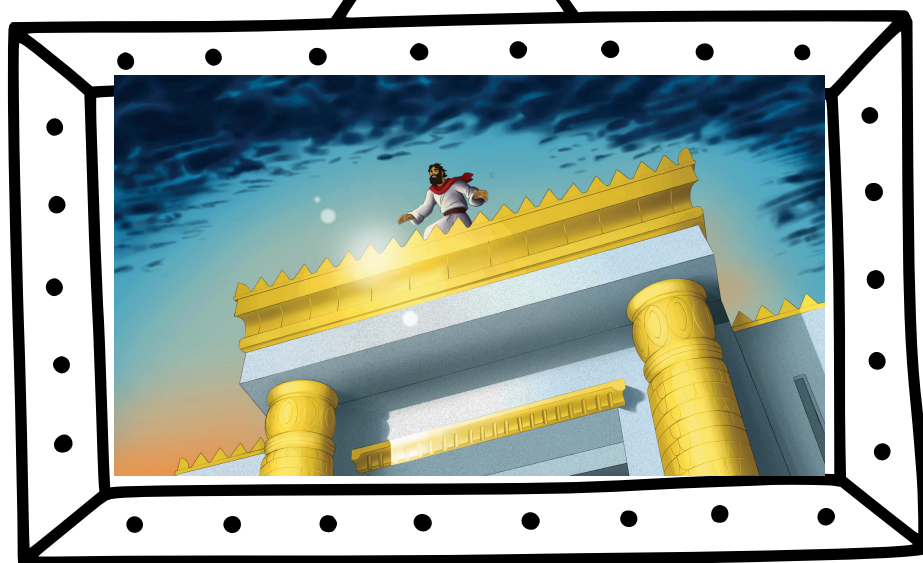
JESUS WAS TEMPTED

STORY POINT:

Jesus was tempted and never sinned.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

The devil tried to get Jesus to sin, but Jesus always did the right thing. Jesus died on the cross and rose again to rescue us from sin. When we are tempted to sin, we can ask Jesus to help us say not to sin.



Read: Matthew 4; Mark 1; Luke 4

Bible Story Recap:



- God's Spirit led Jesus into the wilderness. Jesus did not eat anything there, and He was hungry.
- The devil tried to get Jesus to do the wrong things. He said, "If You really are God's Son, turn these stones into bread." But Jesus said no.
- The devil tried again. He took Jesus to the top of the temple. He said, "If You really are God's Son, jump off this temple. God will protect You, " But Jesus said no.
- Finally, the devil took Jesus up to a high mountain and showed him faraway lands. The devil said, "Look! I will give You these kingdoms if You worship me." But Jesus said no.
- The devil went away, and angels came to help Jesus and serve Him. In all of this, Jesus never sinned.

Make it Fun:



Bake chocolate chip cookies for the family. Allow each family member to eat one cookie, but set aside the rest of the batch to eat later in the week. During the week of waiting, acknowledge the temptation to eat the cookies. Talk with kids about how sin looks and feels enticing to us, but it always leads to consequences. Remind kids that Jesus has defeated sin and given all who believe in Him the power to say no to sin.

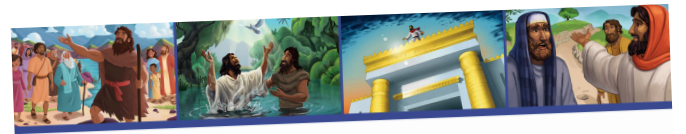
Big Question & Answer
