STORY POINT:

Jesus showed His glory.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

By turning water into special grape juice, Jesus showed His glory. Jesus is God's Son who came to do God's plan. Jesus' disciples saw the miracle and believed in Him. Jesus calls us to believe in Him, too.

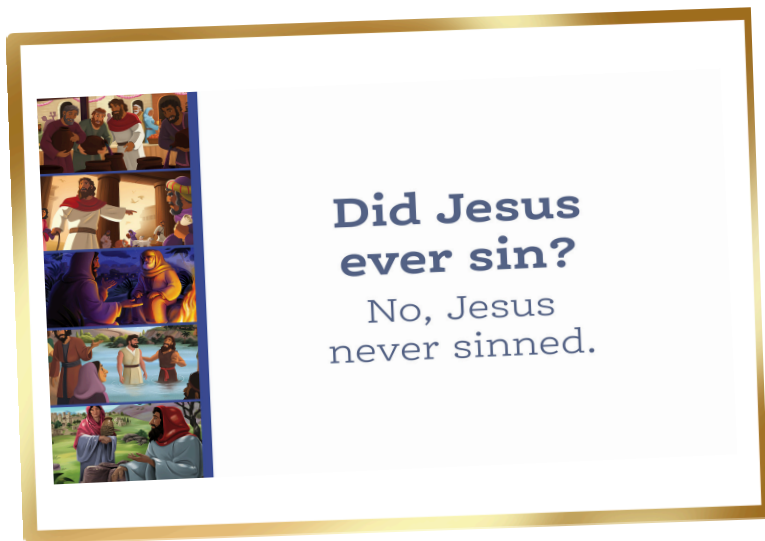


Read: John 1

Bible Story Recap:



- Jesus' mother was at a wedding. Jesus and His followers were there too. Jesus' mother said, "The special grape juice is all gone."
- Jesus told the servants to take six stone jars and fill them to the very top with water. Then He told them to take some out and give it to the host of the party.
- The servants did what Jesus said. When the host drank it, the water had turned into grape juice! The host didn't know where the juice came from, but the servants knew. The host said, "Usually everyone serves the best juice first, but you have saved the best for now."
- This was Jesus' first miracle. He showed His glory, and His followers believed in Him.

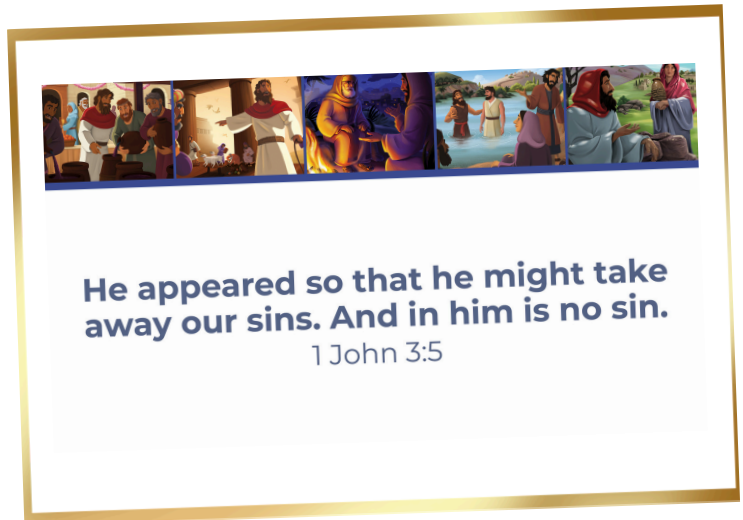
