DEVOTIONAL

JESUS AT PASSOVER

STORY POINT:

Jesus cleaned out the temple.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

Jesus cleansed the temple. He also came to cleanse people from sin by dying on the cross and rising again on the third day. When people trust in Jesus, God cleanses them of their sins, and they will worship Him forever.




Read: John 2



Bible Story Recap:

- Jesus and His friends went to Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover. Jesus found people at the temple selling animals and trading money. They treated God's house like a store!
- Jesus was angry. He made a whip out of cords and made the people leave. He drove out their sheep and oxen. He turned over their tables and dumped their coins.
- "How can You do this?" the people asked. Jesus said, "Destroy this temple, and I will build it again in three days."
- The people were confused. The temple took 46 years to build. No one could build it in three days! But Jesus wasn't talking about the building; He was talking about His body.



Did Jesus ever sin?
No, Jesus never sinned.

Big Question & Answer

Serve:



Volunteer as a family to deep clean a designated space in your church, like the nursery, the kitchen, or storage closets. Make sure toys are clean, clutter is organized, and spaces are free from distractions, so people are free to worship God and make ministry happen in those spaces. Talk about how important it was to Jesus—and how important it is for us—to have space where we can focus on God and worship Him for His goodness.
