# DEVOTIONAL

## JESUS AND NICODEMUS

### STORY POINT:

Jesus taught that anyone who believes in Him will have life with God forever.

### CHRIST CONNECTION:

Jesus is God's one and only Son. God sent Jesus into the world to rescue people from sin. Everyone who believes in Jesus will live with Him forever.




Read: John 3

## Bible Story Recap:



- One night, Nicodemus visited Jesus. Jesus taught Nicodemus an important lesson.
- Jesus said, "A person cannot see God's kingdom unless he is born again." Nicodemus asked, "How can someone who is old be born again?"
- Jesus said that a mother gives birth to her baby, but that life does not last forever. People can get life from God that lasts forever.
- Nicodemus didn't understand, so Jesus told him a story. Long ago, when God's people were in the wilderness, they were bitten by snakes and got sick. God told Moses to make a bronze snake and put it on a pole. When the people looked at the snake, they were healed.
- Jesus said He would be raised up - on a cross - so everyone who believes in Jesus will have life with God forever.



**Did Jesus ever sin?**  
No, Jesus never sinned.
