DEVOTIONAL

JESUS AND THE SAMARITAN WOMAN

STORY POINT:

Jesus told the Samaritan woman that He is God's Son.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

Jesus offered the woman something no one else could give her: living water. Jesus wasn't talking about water to drink, but about the Holy Spirit. Jesus gives the Holy Spirit to those who trust in Him.




Read: John 4



Bible Story Recap:

- Jesus traveled through Samaria. He stopped at a well and asked a woman for a drink. He told her, "If you knew who I am, you would ask Me for a drink. I would give you living water."
- Jesus said anyone who drinks living water will never be thirsty again. The woman wanted this living water. Jesus was talking about the Holy Spirit.
- Jesus knew everything about the woman. He told her, "I am the Messiah." She hurried back to her town and told others about Jesus. They came to the well and listened to Him. The people said, "We know that this really is the Savior of the world!"



Did Jesus ever sin?
No, Jesus never sinned.

Big Question & Answer

Serve:



Take a cooler filled with iced-down water bottles to a local park or busy shopping center. Offer the water bottles for free to people passing by. Pray that God would open the door for spiritual conversations with others as you give them this gift.

Pray specifically that the people who receive the water would thirst for Jesus and come to know Him as their Savior.
