Jesus chose the disciples and still calls people to follow Him. Jesus wants us to turn from our sins and trust in Him as Lord and Savior.

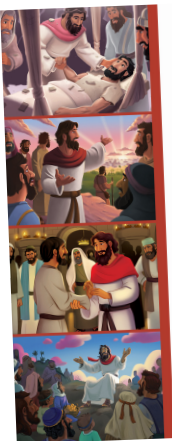


Read: Mark 2-3; Luke 6

Bible Story Recap:



- Jesus was walking by the sea when He saw a man named Levi. Jesus said, "Follow Me." Right away, Levi got up and followed Jesus.
- Later that day, Jesus was eating at Levi's house with many other people. The religious leaders asked, "Why does Jesus eat with sinners?"
- Jesus said, "Healthy people don't need a doctor; sick people do. I came to help sinners, not just good people."
- Then Jesus went up on a mountain. He prayed all night. The next morning, Jesus chose 12 of His followers to be His closest friends, including Peter, James, and John.
