## JESUS' SERMON ON THE MOUNT

### STORY POINT:

Jesus taught about God's kingdom.

### CHRIST CONNECTION:

Jesus taught how people live in God's kingdom. Jesus came to save His people from sin and change how they live. When people follow Jesus, He changes their hearts so they can live in a way that honors Him.

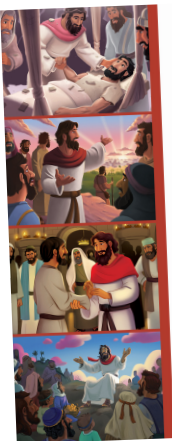


Read: Matthew 5-7; Luke 6

## Bible Story Recap:



- Jesus went up on a mountain. He sat down and taught people about God's kingdom. Jesus taught that people who believe in Him will be blessed.
- Jesus taught how His followers should live differently from people who do not follow Him. Jesus' followers should obey God's law and teach others to obey. If we follow Jesus, we should love our enemies and pray for them. Jesus' followers should also forgive others.
- Jesus said, "Don't collect treasures on earth. These things can be broken or taken away."
- Jesus taught that God takes care of His people. He taught the people many things, and they were amazed.
