DEVOTIONAL

JESUS RAISED A WIDOW'S SON

STORY POINT:

Jesus brought a widow's son back to life.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

Jesus has power over death. After Jesus died on the cross, He rose from the dead. When people repent and trust in Jesus, He makes them alive with God forever.



Read: Luke 7

Bible Story Recap:



- Jesus and His followers were going to a town. When they got there, they saw a funeral. A widow had lost her only son.
- Jesus was sad for her. Her husband had died, and now her son was dead too.
- "Don't cry," Jesus said. He touched the coffin and said, "Young man, get up!" The son sat up and began to talk. Jesus gave him back to his mother.
- The people were amazed! They praised God. News about Jesus spread throughout the land. Jesus brought a widow's son back to life!

Make it Fun:



Sit in a circle as a family and choose one person to be It. They will try to make others smile while each family member tries to keep a straight face and not smile. They can try making funny faces, telling jokes, or other methods to break the sadness. After a few rounds, remind your child that Jesus broke through the sadness of death with His power and compassion. This miracle points us to the greatest miracle—when Jesus rose from the dead so that everyone who trusts in Him can have eternal life.
