DEVOTIONAL

JESUS WAS ANOINTED

STORY POINT:

Jesus forgave a woman's sins.

CHRIST CONNECTION:

Everyone has sinned and deserves punishment from God. But Jesus, the only sinless one, died in our place to take the punishment for our sin. When we trust in Jesus, we are forgiven of all our sins and are made right with God.



Read: Luke 7

Bible Story Recap:



- Simon invited Jesus to his house for dinner. Jesus was at the table when a woman came. She had a jar of perfume and was crying.
- The woman washed Jesus' feet with her tears, wiped them with her hair, kissed them, and put perfume on them.
- Simon didn't understand why Jesus would let the woman do this, so Jesus told Simon a story: Two men owed a banker money - one a lot of money and the other a little bit. The banker told them both that they didn't need to pay him back.
- Jesus asked, "Who loved the banker more?" Simon said, "The one who owed more." Jesus said the woman came to Jesus because she believed in Him and loved Him. Jesus forgave the woman's sins.

Make it Fun:



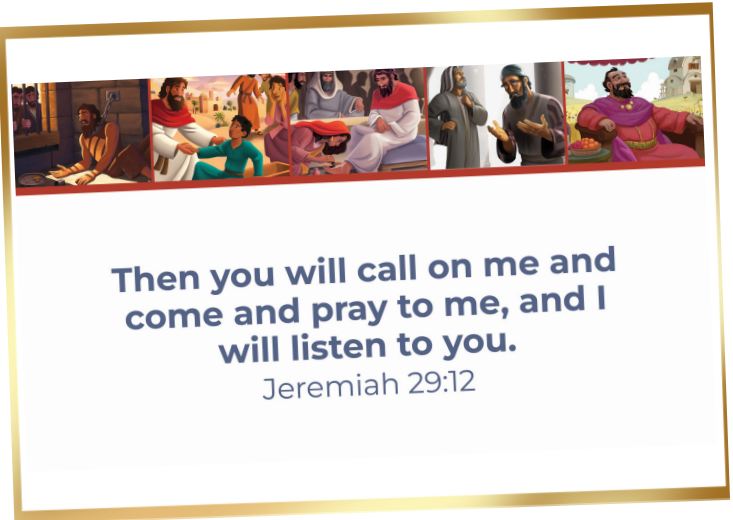

Afterward, discuss the story of the woman who poured perfume on Jesus' feet as an act of worship. Talk about the ways your family can show love and adoration to Jesus.

Big Question & Answer

Serve:

Afterwards, talk about how the woman in the story gave something valuable to worship Jesus and discuss how your family can continue to give as an act of worship to Jesus.
